**Our Mission:** To groom every child into a loving, caring, productive citizen, capable of facing challenges in life with confidence, imbibing the qualities of truthfulness, humility, integrity and a deep concern for the fellow beings.

The academic year 2019-2020 has been very purposeful and fruitful. The year witnessed many changes The academic year 2021-2022 started from July with the online mode.

**Staff:** Our strength is our faculty, who form the strong pillars of our institution. It is their dedication, commitment, care, and affection that has enhanced the healthy learning environment in the school. We have at present 10 teaching and 4 non-teaching members on the staff.

The total strength of the school as on 1<sup>st</sup> July 2021 was 308. The staff strength was teaching 16 and non-teaching 4. We scaled up to class VI and had appointed extra teachers as per our requirement.

**Education during the Pandemic:** Pandemic caused a lot of chaos to the system of education and schools were forced to shut down during the lock down period, and the transition of students and teachers to online teaching was inevitable.

As it was the need of the hour all our staff were trained to take up online classes and we were able to handle the programmed well with the co-operation of the students as well as parents.

We not only concentrated on the academics but also ensured that the overall development of the students took place with academic and cultural activities hand in hand.

The parents were constantly in touch with the teachers in case of clarification required. We used to conduct class wise online meetings with the parents to guide them to give the right instructions to their wards.

The parents were very happy the way in which we managed the classes resulting in good name & fame to our school which is has reflected in our admission process for the academic year 2022-2023.

The education dept had sent a circular on online classes and all the requirements were fulfilled accordingly ensuring the holistic development of the students. Teacher's role in the same was fantastic. The bridge course, timely tests were conducted. Results were shared with the students / Parents. Activities were done virtually during the academic year.

**Infrastructure:** Catering to the needs of the increasing strength and scaling up of classes each year we have already completed the construction of Phase II C, wherein we added one floor to the existing building and a toilet block. We are self sufficient with ample class rooms for the next academic year, library, science laboratory etc. Phase III (new building block) construction is in progress which on completion will provide us all the required facilities up to Class X.


Enclosed below is a month-wise update of activities carried out in the institution.
